

## Benefits of a Non-Practicing RM MABC Membership

BCCNM Registered Midwives under the Non-Practicing status are eligible for a Non-Practicing MABC membership. The fee for NP members is \$62.50 quarterly or \$150 annually.

## Benefits of an MABC membership:

- 1. **MABC Website**: Access to the MABC website where members can read past newsletters and reports, see a list of current board members, view presentations from past Annual General Meetings (AGMs), etc.
- 2. **MABC Governance and Programs communications**: Members will receive messages from the MABC, including updates, announcements, and newsletters.
- 3. **CAM/ACSF membership & Journal**: MABC membership includes membership in the Canadian Association of Midwives (CAM/ACSF). As a member of CAM, you will receive the "Canadian Journal of Midwifery" three times a year.
- 4. **AGM:** Members are welcome to attend the MABC AGM every year.
- 5. **Ancillary Wellness Programs**: The MABC provides 2 wellness programs to promote the overall well-being of members. These services are offered at no cost to help address a variety of personal and/or workplace issues experienced by MABC members by offering a comprehensive scope of secure and confidential counselling and work-life services.
- 6. **Parental Leave Benefits Program:** This program provides a benefit of \$1,000 per week, for a maximum of 17 consecutive weeks to registered midwives that go on parental leave and that meet the eligibility requirements.
- 7. **RRSP Matching Contributions Program:** The MABC and the Provincial Government will match up to a maximum of \$4500.00 that registered midwives, in good standing with the MABC, contribute to their RRSP account.
- 8. **Journal of Obstetrics and Gynaecology Canada:** MABC membership grants all MABC members access to research, reviews, case reports, and commentaries published by the JOGC, such as the SOGC Clinical Practice Guidelines.
- 9. **GynZone access:** MABC membership grants members free access to GynZone. GynZone is a web and app-based program that offers 24/7 access to live conference/webinars, online courses, and educational videos.
- 10. **Midwifery Emergency Skills Program (MESP)**: MESP was created by UBC Midwifery and is delivered by MABC, offering midwives members the opportunity to be recertified on a BCCNM required schedule, at a subsidized rate.
- 11. **Rural Start Up Grant Program (RPSGP)**: Non-practicing members who intend to become practicing members are welcome to explore their options and apply for startup funding.
- 12. **BCRM Ref App:** MABC members have access to the BCRM Ref mobile pharmacology app. The app offers select basic information (pharmacology and action, uses, contraindications and

- cautions) of all the medications and therapeutics commonly prescribed, ordered, and administered by midwives in British Columbia.
- 13. Interprofessional member engagement grant program (submissions received until April 30, 2023): This fund provides retroactive and ongoing compensation to members who have participated in inter-professional work for which they would not otherwise receive adequate compensation.
- 14. **Midwifery Leadership bursary (submissions received until Feb 28, 2023)** The purpose of the grant is to support up to five registered midwives per fiscal year in the pursuit of leadership training.
