

Seeking Full Time Locum - September 1st 2018

We are looking for a Full Time Locum -General or New Registrant -to take over the caseload of a team member taking a leave for the next 12 months, with the possibility of continuing on for longer. We are flexible on start dates although ideally beginning September 1st, 2018.

Our practice was established in 2008. We are an urban/rural practice with caseload for 3 full-time midwives. Our Midwives share call and clinic with privileges at Abbotsford Regional Hospital and Chilliwack General Hospital. Abbotsford is a Level 2 and Chilliwack is a Level 1 site. We have very good working relationships with the staff and consultants at both sites. We are fortunate to work in a very supportive collaborative community. We work out of a lovely clinic space, located one block from the hospital. The clinic space is a residential home, and is very cozy and comfortable. We use Oscar for electronic charting and have wonderful administrative staff. We work closely with local doulas and childbirth educators.

Our homebirth rate is about 15% and growing, and we enjoy many repeat clients and have a very high rate of multiples. Since there are many Midwives in the community, one is always able to easily find a second attendant for homebirth back ups.

Abbotsford is a thriving family-friendly community with endless opportunities for work and play. Nestled amongst farmland, mountains and the Fraser River, it is a paradise for those who love the outdoors. Local organic farms and farmers market are abundant, and there is a cozy, historical downtown with good shopping and eating. There is almost no traffic, and parking is always free!
